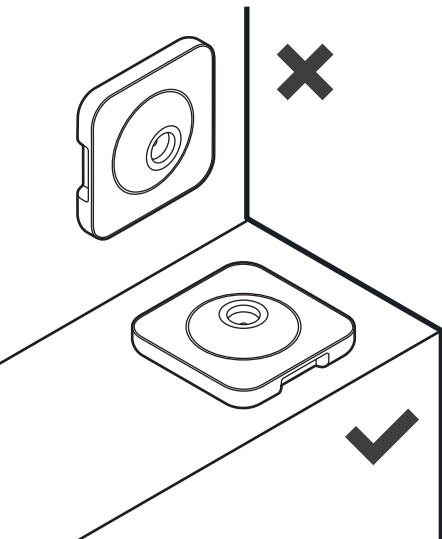

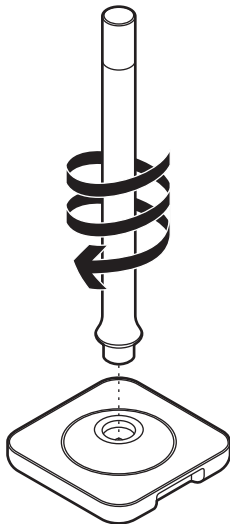
Find a space where you can place the antenna upright.

Keep the antenna oriented upright.
Wall mounting is not recommended.



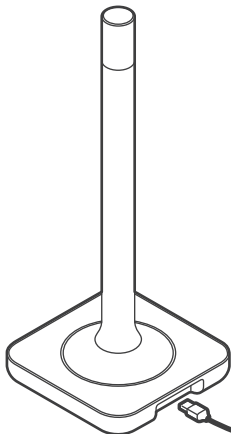

Screw the antenna to the base.
Be careful not to overtighten.

Plug the USB-C cable into the base.

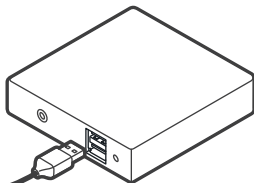

Connect the USB cable to a USB 2.0 or later port on a device running Home Assistant 2025.5 or newer.

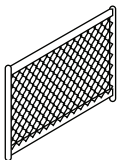
If you have not used Z-Wave before, Home Assistant should discover the device.

Tips

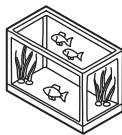
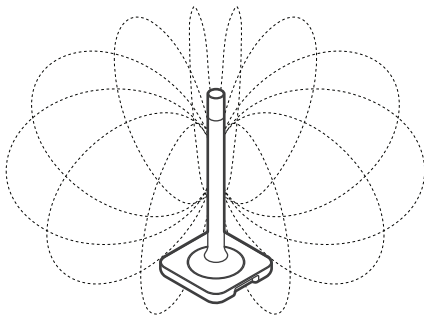
Keep the antenna in a central location, away from materials or devices that may block radio transmission or cause interference.



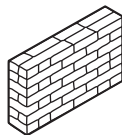
✗ Wire mesh



✗ Wireless transmitters



✗ Body of water



✗ Thick walls

Z-Wave Long Range connects directly to the antenna and does not form a mesh with other devices. Consider this when deciding where to place your antenna.
